

Dr. Rhoda Mhiripiri-Reed, Hopkins Schools Superintendent

Dr. Rhoda Mhiripiri-Reed has served in public education for over two decades. After graduating from Yale with a teaching license, Dr. Mhiripiri-Reed returned to Minnesota to begin her teaching career. Dr. Rhoda Mhiripiri-Reed later completed Harvard University's doctoral program in Education Leadership and has since dedicated her life and career to improving the lives of others.

In 2016, Dr. Rhoda Mhiripiri-Reed became the first woman and the first person of color to serve as a Hopkins superintendent. Under her leadership, Hopkins Public Schools developed a strategic plan called Vision 2031, built upon the core belief that every student deserves a brilliant future. Dr. Mhiripiri-Reed, alongside her team, her students, and her community, is working to reimagine our educational system from the ground up.
